Did you know

- EdF plans to build two giant reactors at Hinkley.
- The European Pressurised Reactor (EPR) has been plagued with construction problems and overspend in Finland and France. Many have concerns over its safety.
- The EPR's highly radioactive 'superheated' fuel rods will be left on site for at least 100 years, increasing its exposure to terrorist risks.
- Studies have shown increased cancer and infant mortality downwind from Hinkley Point.
- The UK taxpayer is currently expected to pay £83 billion and rising to decommission existing nuclear sites.
- The cost of n-waste management from a new generation of reactors will be capped by government. Taxpayers will pay the rest.
- Existing UK nuclear sites are mostly around coastlines which are jeopardised by rising sea levels.
- The Fukushima accident in Japan has shown how dangerous nuclear power can be.

Stop Hinkley was founded in 1983 to campaign against the proposed Hinkley C development. SHE played a major part in the 14-month public enquiry during 1988-9, including the co-ordination of evidence from dozens of individuals and organisations. Over 20,000 people were encouraged to object.

We have continued to campaign for alternative renewable energy sources and energy conservation measures.

The closure of Hinkley A was announced in May 2000, we believe as a result of our campaigning.

Now, however, Hinkley C is back on the agenda and Stop Hinkley is campaigning vigorously on behalf of its members. We inform the press of developments, meet with industry and regulators and network with experts and groups to protest against nuclear power locally and nationally.

Our website www.stophinkley.org is regularly updated with the latest news and developments in the campaign, and is a useful resource for information.

- The UK does not need nuclear: We can meet electricity demand with clean, safe renewable energy and efficient consumption.
- The South West's marine renewable resource wind, waves and tides could produce more power than Hinkley C, and much more safely.
- Nuclear power is not cheap, not safe and not necessary. As the late Michael Meacher, MP and Stop Hinkley patron, said: "The UK needs new nuclear like a hole in the head."
